**17/131 To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2017**

**IT WAS RESOLVED** to adopt the minutes of the parish council meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2017 and authorise the Chairman to sign the minutes.

#### **17/132 Matters Arising not on the Agenda**

- i) Highway and traffic matters – update: The new road network should be completed by 23/3/17.
- ii) Road markings – Lancaster Approach and Village Green – N.L.C have agreed to re-mark these areas.
- iii) Overgrown hedge, Top Road – N.L.C have inspected this hedge and have indicated that it is not infringing the highway and will therefore be added to a list of works which will be undertaken in due course.

**17/133 Dong Energy Cables**– to discuss the demolition of the old airfield Eastfield Road, North Killingholme. The new cable to run through TOTAL land will result in an air raid shelter being demolished. Some local residents have expressed disappointment in this demolition as it will affect the aviation heritage trail. The clerk was asked to contact Tony Dale of DDM to express the disappointment of residents in the area.

**17/134 Report from Total LOR** – Ms Brimble reported that the plant is running satisfactorily at present. Ms Brimble agreed to check if LOR had been consulted on the new bus stop and route (as the parish hadn't been consulted).

The member of the public present expressed concerns regarding the number of lorries parking overnight along Lancaster Approach - the security on this industrial site do not appear to want to do anything about this.
