Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held in the Village Hall at 7.30 pm on Monday 10th April 2017 at 7.30pm

Representatives from the Hornsea Wind farm Project(1) addressed the meeting to advise how their project would affect the residents of North Killingholme. Community liaison officer, dereth Morgan advised the meeting that this is the worlds largest wind farm project and in our area runs from north Cotes to North Killingholme. The route is approximately 39km long and work will commence in June through to september. A traffic management plan has been drawn up and no project reffic will pass through the village. They also intend to by-pass the air raid shelters and not disturb them.

There is an east Coast Community Fund – with funds allocated through Grantscape for projects which will benefit the community.

Cllr Clark suggested to the members of the public that they, as a residents group, write to the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding this matter.

The member of the public responsible for the newly formed neighbourhood watch group suggested that she put the details of the Hornsea wind farm contacts on the neighbourhood watch website – details to be provided.

17/12 Parish and Village issues

- a) Grant application update – the application has been submitted and acknowledgement received.
- b) Speed along St Crispins Close – It was agreed to place a notice on the neighbourhood watch website asking residents to drive slowly and carefully along St Crispins Close.
- c) North Killingholme Airfield Licencing – Site was granted an open storage licence in 1979, no limits imposed.
- d) Playground inspection report from N.L.C – The inspection report indicated that the slide had rough edges to it and a descale and bead of sealant down the edges was recommended. Cllr Russell agreed to take a look at the slide and make repairs if possible.
- e) New village/parish matters – It was noted that drains and gullies in North Killingholme need jetting – clerk to be informed of drains which require this service.
 The footpath on East Holton Road(from Garden Village) up to Chase Hill Road needs scraping off as it has become very narrow – it is also a cycle path and therefore needs attention as soon as possible.
 New light fittings are required in the toilets in the village hall – 6 – Cllr Broddley will purchase and arrange to be fitted. The doors to the toilets need planing off as they are sticking.
 The chairman thanked Cllr Robinson for the historical display she put on in the village hall at the weekend.
 The village is suffering from flies again – it does not appear that they are coming from the waste on the airfield – environment officers at N.L.C are continuing to investigate.
 The notice board in the churchyard – originally donated by a member of the 550 squadron, is in need of refurbishment – sanding and varnishing – Cllr Broddley thought it could probably be done at the same time the village seat is refurbished.
 A historical board – originally in the Shell office has been returned to the village and will be hung in the village hall.
