## **North Killingholme Parish Council**

### **Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held in the Village Hall at 7.30 pm on Tuesday 11th June 2018 at 7.30pm.**

#### **PUBLIC FORUM**

A member of the public requested that residents were permitted to speak under agenda item 9(iv) – the chairman advised that she would seek the permission of councillors at that stage to suspend standing orders and allow members of the public to participate in the discussion.

A member of the public advised that HGV traffic which is diverted along Top Road/East Halton Road in the event of a road closure – do make this a habit and continue to travel this way.

A Police Officer has visited the area and has booked HGV's travelling illegally along Top Road and East Halton Road. Residents have been advised that Officers will attend again and target the worst offending companies. The Police have also agreed to visit the companies advising them that they will be undertaking these checks/enforcement which will hopefully discourage drivers from using this route.

**IT WAS RESOLVED** to adopt the minutes of the parish council meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and authorise the Chairman to sign the minutes.

#### **18/30 Clerks/Chairmans report**

Clerk continues to remind N.L.C of the outstanding works required to the public footpath – Neve Cole Way and the requested bridge repairs.

The chairman sought permission from the meeting to purchase 2 sheets at £80/sheet to make the necessary repairs to the play equipment. The meeting agreed that this purchase could be made immediately under emergency powers.

**18/31 Report from Total LOR** – Rebecca Brimble advised the meeting that they have recently received some comments regarding noise and flaring from the refinery. The noise was due to a unit start up. TLOR would like to apologise to residents for any inconvenience and disruption this may have caused. Residents who contacted the refinery were visited by the Shift Controller to investigate and discuss with concerned residents. Changes to normal operations are always communicated via the 0800 number which provides a recorded message for local residents and businesses. The freephone number to call is 0800 393 780. Alternatively if residents have any concern on a safety or environmental matter, please contact the refinery on 01469 563 300 to enable TLOR to investigate and respond promptly. The meeting agreed that the LOR history/open day could be advertised on the parish council website – Rebecca Brimble to send through material when available.

### 18/35 North Lincolnshire Council Matters

i) Reports from N.L.C representatives: No reports to receive.

ii) Traffic/Highways – This matter was covered within the public forum section.

iii) Flashing Speed awareness sign – The promised donations for this sign are now coming in. It is hoped that the sign can be purchased by September.

iv) Open storage concerns at Lancaster Approach – The chairman asked the meeting to allow standing orders to be suspended to allow members of the public to participate in this agenda item. The meeting agreed and standing orders were suspended.

The response from the environmental officer at N.L.C had been circulated to parish councillors and members of the public prior to the meeting. The monitoring (dust) on East Halton Road needs a long period of data collection before the data can be ratified. The salt heap does not need a permit but planning permission is required. N.L.C have advised the site owners of this fact and a retrospective planning application may be submitted. This will provide the parish council with the opportunity to request

conditions be placed on this planning consent – lorry wash facility, sheeted lorries, bunding around the salt heap etc.

Residents on east Halton Road have been provided with a dust monitoring record sheet which they will complete to provide N.L.C with evidence of the dust problem. Residents have also sent photographs of the salt on the cars and road to N.L.C for their consideration.

A meeting at N.L.C is scheduled for 12/6/18 regarding the required planning permission for the salt heap and with highways officers regarding highway problems associated with this salt heap. Clerk to try and get a report on this meeting.

v) New N.L.C/Highways matters to report – Potholes outstanding on Eastfield Road – some have been done but not others. Multiple pot holes on the highway to the entrance of the Ashbourne Hotel on Vicarage lane. Grass verges around the parish need cutting – visibility is very poor.
